He is a member of the LCMS Commission on Theology and Church Relations. He is a frequent speaker for conferences, retreats, and workshops; and is a regular guest on "Issues, Etc.," KFUO "Studio A" and "Table Talks" radio programs, having guested also on "The Lutheran Hour" and "Point of Truth" television. Fickenscher served Messiah Lutheran Church in Midland, Michigan, and Peace Lutheran Church in Garland, Texas. He is married to wife, Claire. They are the very proud parents of Rachel, Daniel and Gabriel.
